SOS has been approached by Dr Elizabeth Taylor, a post-doctoral researcher at RMIT, seeking greater participation for a research survey on residential car parking space and car parking policies in Australian cities.

The aim of the research is to find out how different people in Australian cities use on-street and off-street car parking space in and around their homes; and what they think about local car parking availability and car parking policies.
